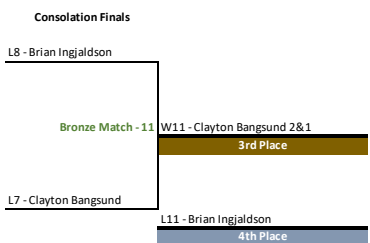
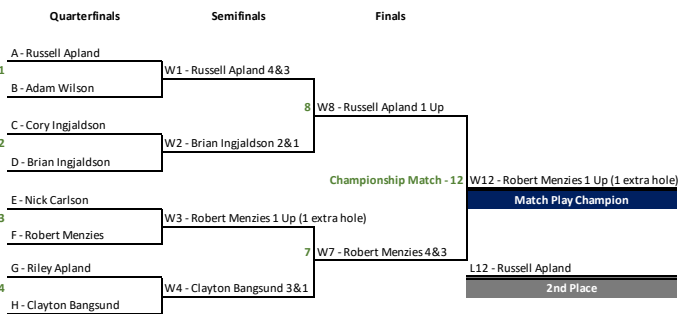


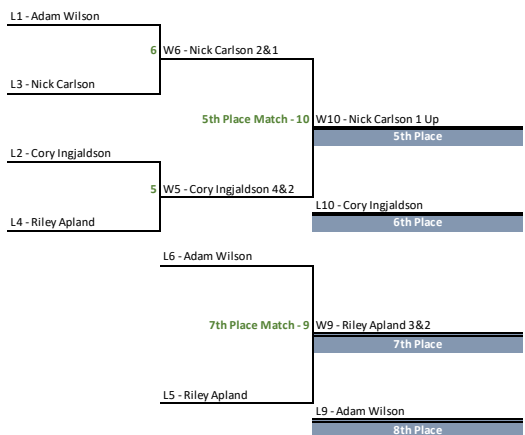

Rules

- tournament entry fee is \$20 (does not include green fees)
- for tournament purposes, no strokes are given between players to compensate for handicap differential; the competition is "even up"
- immediately before tournament play begins, names will be randomly drawn for bracket positions A through H
- winter rules are in effect
- White Bear rules are in effect (i.e. stroke, no distance for lost ball or out of bounds; drop at point of entry)
- double bogey max for both match & stroke play competitions (i.e. no player can win a hole with a double bogey or card a higher score)
- concessions are permitted, but do not be overly-generous with conceding putts to your opponent because it impacts the stroke play competition
- each match is nine holes
- tied matches will be decided by sudden death playoff hole(s), where possible; if additional holes are not possible, tiebreaker will be improvised as the circumstances permit (i.e. chipping or putting competition, etc.) - there will be no countbacks
- stroke play ties will result in players sharing the hardware - again, no countbacks
- closest to the pin is available for tee shot on any hole of tournament play (including playoff holes), par 3 or otherwise; measure and record the distance on your scorecard, and identify the hole of play
- longest drive is available on hole 4 (fairway only) during any round of tournament play, including playoff holes; original tee shot only (i.e. no player can win longest drive with "three off the tee")
- one scorecard per match; Squabbitt app will be used to facilitate live scoring
