Event Highlights & Notes

In 2020, 8 sub-80 rounds were recorded and 38 birdies were carded.
 In 2021, 1 sub-par round and 8 sub-80 rounds were recorded. 42 birdies were carded along with 1 eagle.
 In 2022, 1 sub-par round and 9 sub-40 rounds were recorded. 20 birdies were carded during the first 27-hole version of the event.
 In 2023, 1 sub-par round and 12 sub-40 rounds were recorded. 17 birdies were carded along with 1 eagle. Remarkably, Hole #7 only surrendered one birdie.
 To date: Hole #1 has been the most difficult. Through four years of competition, it has surrendered only 4 birdies.
 Hole #5 has been the second toughest hole, surrendering only 5 birdies.
 Hole #7 has been the easiest hole, surrendering 36 birdies and 1 eagle.
 Hole #9 has been the second easiest hole, surrendering 15 birdies.
